#### 121/23. North Yorkshire Councillor Report. The chairman moved to this item.

Cllr Staveley had circulated his report and the clerk had posted it on the website.

A 4.99% increase to the council precept had been approved by NY Council which would be implemented in April. There was increased financial pressure in regard to adult social care and children's services which has meant that some council's had faced serious financial problems including bankruptcy. NY Council has managed to absorb much of the negative burden resulting from amalgamating various district councils but still faces challenges as a result of inheriting some buildings and services.

The locality grants were to continue in the short term with councillors being able to help projects financially within their area.

The mayoral elections will be taking place in May and this position will attract additional funding to NY council of £85 million.
