

Stainforth Village Hall is located in the parish of Stainforth in North Yorkshire and situated in the Yorkshire Dales National Park.

It was gifted to the community on 9th September 1937 by Thomas Foster Knowles of Stainforth and in 1954 transferred to the Committee.

It is a charitable organisation run by a management committee.

The hall is available for community club meetings, parties and celebrations, workshops, exercise and wellbeing classes, table tennis and private hire events.

It is used by Stainforth Parish Council and YDNP for meetings and as a polling station.

The hall seats 50 people and has a newly refurbished kitchen and toilet facilities (as of 9th June 2024) It has a table tennis table and indoor bowls equipment for hire.

The hall committee organises annually fundraising events such as Afternoon teas, Ribblesdale House garden party with a live band, village BBQ on the green with live music and a wreath making workshop at Christmas.

The committee aims to provide a community hub for the village residents and local communities and the broader areas to enjoy.
