Kex Gill reopened

One of the main routes in the North of England which has been closed due to a landslip has reopened following an extensive repair scheme.

North Yorkshire Council's highways team were forced to close the A59 at Kex Gill in February, after the start of the year was one of the wettest on record.

The prolonged wet weather made conditions even more challenging on the road, which is a key route linking the east and west of the country. During the repair scheme extended working hours helped ensure the road was reopened as soon as possible.

The most effective repair scheme was chosen, which involved the installation of more than 85 metres of steel sheets – known as piles – to create a structural wall.

The road behind the sheet piles was then reconstructed, along with drainage works and the relocation of telephone cables.

The focus can now turn back to the multi-million pound re-alignment project. The latest landslip proves more than ever that the scheme is essential to ensure the future of this key east-west route.
